Continuing stormwater infrastructure improvements

~~\$300,000 project approved by the Board of County Commissioners~~

PASCO COUNTY --- The second phase of stormwater infrastructure work in Pasco County is underway on the canal system north of Millstone Drive at Seven Springs Boulevard. Crews are cleaning the canal to the east – north of Millstone and south of Overview Drive. The project is expected to take six weeks.

The Board of County Commissioners approved \$300,000 in December, 2015 to be used to improve storm water infrastructure in Pasco County with current contractor, WLW Construction.

The contractor has completed the first phase of the project, cleaning the Oak Ridge Canal. The canal is south of Coronet Drive – running from Seven Springs to Meadow Point. This phase of the project used about \$127,000. The second phase will use the remainder of the \$300,000 the Board of County Commissioners approved.
