



PASCO COUNTY PASADENA HILLS AREA PLAN

CHARRETTE

Pasco County is hosting a Charrette as a part of the Pasadena Hills area study (shown on map below). This study will result in the creation of a land use and transportation plan that identifies growth patterns to the 2050 horizon.

The Charrette provides an open opportunity for community participation during the design process. During Day One, the design team will present a recap of the information gained in the stakeholder interviews, and a set of “starter ideas” based on the synthesis of stakeholder input. The team will facilitate a public open house in the evening.

For the final two days of the Charrette, the design team will work on detailing elements of the plan. This plan will include a street framework, an open space system, an environmental strategy and story, and general ideas on the placement, density and intensity of land uses. Citizens are encouraged to stop by and give their comments and input to the process on March 22, 2007, though no formal meetings will be scheduled.


