

Crews Lake Cabin Rental Policies & Procedures

1. The Crews Lake Cabin is available for meetings and retreats by non-profit and profit organizations and corporations only. Person(s) submitting the reservation must be a representative of the organization.
2. There is NO SMOKING permitted inside the cabin. Smoking is allowed outside. Please use ashtrays.
3. No person under 21 years of age will be permitted to register for a cabin or campsite. No one under 18 years of age can be left alone in the cabin.
4. Cabin may not exceed 15 persons during any overnight stay.
5. All campers must register before the park closes.
6. Ground fires are prohibited except in metal fire rings provided by park staff. Grills are provided for cooking. No cooking inside the cabins. All fire **must** be kept within the metal fire ring. Please no wood, propane, charcoal, or gas grills. No deep fryers.
7. Collecting or cutting down firewood is **prohibited**. If park staff does not provide firewood, you must bring your own. Remember that dead trees play a very important role in the life cycle of the forest.
8. Pets are not allowed in the cabin. Dogs are allowed in the park on a leash in designated areas.
9. The combination to the lock on the main gate has been provided to you to allow campers the privilege of entering and exiting the park after hours. Please lock the gate after exit and entry. Do not let anyone in who is not a registered camper.
10. Camping area QUIET HOURS are from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Please do not disturb other park users. Campers disturbing others will be instructed to leave the park after one warning from park staff.
11. All nonregistered campers must leave the park by 10:00 p.m. (beginning of Quiet Hours).
12. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED!!** Anyone with alcoholic beverages will immediately lose their camping privileges.
13. Check out is at 11:00 a.m. for campers. Campers who wish to make reservations for additional nights MUST check availability prior to 10:00 a.m. on their departure date.
14. Campsite and cabin must be kept clean and orderly. Deposit litter in containers. Grills and fire pits will be emptied and cleaned by park staff. Cabins will be inspected before checkout.
15. All vehicles must stay on approved driving surfaces at all times. No recreational vehicles (RVs) in the camping area. Please no generators.
16. **All incidents are to be reported immediately to the park staff during park hours.** For medical or police emergencies, dial 9-1-1. After park hours, contact the Pasco County Sheriff's Dispatch at (727) 844-7711 for disturbances and operational emergencies.
17. Campers may stay for a total of 14 days within a 30-day period in any Pasco County park camping facility. After 14 days, campers must leave for 60 days.
18. Please **NO** use of pellet guns, air guns, BB guns, paint balls, fireworks or any other weapons or devices that can harm others.
19. **Any infraction of the Park Rules and Regulations or County Ordinances will result in immediate revocation of camping and cabin use privileges WITHOUT A REFUND.**

** Cabin fees are as follows: Day use:
\$10/hr (category II fee schedule)
\$15/hr (category III fee schedule)

Overnight retreat:
\$50/night (April 1st – September 30th)
\$60/night (October 1st – March 31st)
