

CAMP FEES: AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2010

Primitive Campsite: \$5.00 per night/year round (8 persons/ two tents) (10 sites available)

Primitive Cabin (1):

\$10/per night—April 1 thru September 30

\$15/per night—October 1 thru March 31



Campsite w/electric:

\$15.00 per night-April 1 thru September 30

\$20.00 per night-October 1 thru March 31

Primitive Group Campsites:

	April-Sept	Oct-March
9-16 persons	\$20.00/night	\$25.00/night
17-24 persons	\$25.00/night	\$30.00/night
25-32 person	\$30.00/night	\$35.00/night

CAMPING REGULATIONS:

- Camping is available on a first come, first serve basis
- The Primitive Campground is located just a short .5 mile hike from the southern most parking area.
- Campsites with electric are located in the recreation field.
- Pets are not permitted in the Primitive Camp areas.
- All campers must register at the park office and be set up one hour prior to the park closing time posted at the front gate.
- The gate combination will be given to registered guests only. This policy is for your protection. Please do not give the combination to anyone not in your party.
- All campers must lock the front gate upon entering or leaving the park after hours.
- The pay phone is located in the southern most parking area. For emergencies dial 911. Non-emergencies dial (352) 518-5000.

- #2 LARGE PAVILION: \$40.00 w/o electric or \$45.00 w/electric to reserve (18 tables)
- #4 SMALL SHELTER: \$25.00 to reserve (6 tables)


*Fishing is permitted along the river. Persons 16 years old and above, must have a valid Florida fishing license.


