



## **Pasco County 2016 Legislative Day**

Pasco County Legislative Day, which occurred on Tuesday, February 2, 2016 at the capitol in Tallahassee, provided an opportunity for our County Commissioners and staff to present Pasco County's legislative priorities to the state's lawmakers. In addition, it provided a chance for Tallahassee folks who aren't familiar with Pasco County to get better acquainted.

The Commissioners met with and received an update on the 2016 Legislative Session from our Pasco Legislative Delegation: Senator John Legg, Senator Wilton Simpson, Representative Amanda Murphy, Representative Richard Corcoran, and Representative Danny Burgess. Transportation needs in Pasco were discussed during a meeting with Jim Boxold, Secretary of FDOT. Commissioners also had an opportunity to visit with Governor Rick Scott, and Senate President Andy Gadinier.

While in Tallahassee, the Pasco contingent attended the Florida Association of Counties Legislative Day on Wednesday, February 3<sup>rd</sup> to assist with their lobbying efforts to protect home rule and prevent unfunded mandates.
