Transportation Safety Projects

- US 19 Median Channelization
- Interstate 75 – CR 54 Interchange and 6-Laning from Pasco Road to SR 581
- Seven Springs Boulevard Median and Safety Improvements from Perrine Ranch Road to Pinellas County Line (Including Intersection Improvements at Seven Springs and Mitchell Boulevard)
- Ten Intersection Improvements in West, Central and East Pasco County
- Clinton Avenue – Widen Lanes to 12 feet and provide paved shoulders from Pasadena Lane to Fort King Road
- SR 54 – Widen Lanes to 12 feet and provide paved shoulders from Curley Road to Morris Bridge Road
- Main Street (In cooperation with the City of New Port Richey) – Widen Lanes to 12 feet and provide paved shoulders from Congress Street to Rowan Road
- Starkey Trail Extension along Massachusetts Avenue from Congress Street to Starkey Boulevard
- Thirty-four Transit Shelters at County Bus Stops in East and West Pasco County
- County-Wide Right-of-Way Acquisition

Environmental Lands Acquisition

The Environmental Lands Acquisition Task Force recommended the formation of a Lands Acquisition Program for Pasco County. By acquiring interests in real property by purchase, conservation easement or the establishment of partnership agreements the County seeks to provide the following for the residents of Pasco County:

- Protect the remaining natural communities for future generations
- Connect major public lands through the acquisition of corridors connecting them
- Conserve native plants, animals and their habitat
- Protect water resources and wetlands
- Enhance natural resource-based recreational and educational opportunities
- Promote the preservation of lands near residential neighborhoods that increase the quality of life

- 70 Automatic Defibrillators
- 50 Mobile Data Terminals (Laptops) for Sheriff's Office
- 792 Police Package Vehicles – Marked Units for Sheriff's Office
- 8 Additional Ambulances for Emergency Medical Services
- 8 Additional Fire Apparatus for Fire Services
- 2 Additional Fire/Emergency Medical Service Stations
