The Pasco County Board of County Commissioners awarded the Construction Contract for the Clinton Avenue Project (West of Ft. King Hwy. (CR 41) to East of US 301) to Pepper Contracting Services, Inc. on August 21, 2012. The Notice to Proceed with the Project was issued to the Contractor for September 4, 2012. **PUBLIC WORKSHOP INFORMATION SHEET**  
**Thursday, September 20, 2012**

Welcome to the Public Workshop for the Clinton Avenue Project (West of Ft. King Hwy. (CR 41) to East of US 301). All necessary planning, design and right-of-way acquisition for the Clinton Avenue Project has been completed. The Pasco County Board of County Commissioners awarded the Construction Contract for the Clinton Avenue Project to Pepper Contracting Services, Inc. on August 21, 2012. The Notice to Proceed with the Project was issued to the Contractor for September 4, 2012.

Generally, the Clinton Avenue Project consists of the widening of the existing two (2) lane undivided roadway to a four (4) lane divided roadway with turn lanes. The Project includes: roadway items; drainage ponds, structures and pipe; signing and pavement markings; signalization; water main; and, associated facilities in accordance with the Construction Contract.

The Clinton Avenue Project starts from West of Ft. King Highway and extends to the East of US 301 – approximately 1.8 miles. Approximately 1,200 feet west of Ft. King Hwy., the roadway will transition from the existing two (2) lane undivided roadway to a four (4) lane divided roadway. At the Clinton Avenue and Ft. King Highway Intersection, exclusive right-turn and left-turn lanes will be added.

Between Ft. King Hwy. and US 301, the Project will widen the existing two (2) lane undivided roadway to a four (4) lane divided roadway. The Project will include a raised median, 4-foot bike lanes, curb and gutter and 5-foot sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. At the Clinton Avenue and US 301 intersection, an exclusive right-turn lane and dual left-turn lanes will be added. East of US 301 intersection, the roadway will transition back to the existing two (2) lane undivided roadway in about 1,200 feet.

There are many existing Private Utilities in the Project area. Among those Private Utilities are Tampa Electric Company (TECO) Energy, TECO Peoples Gas, Century Link, Withlacoochee River Electric Cooperative (WREC), Progress Energy and Brighthouse Networks. Therefore, the Clinton Avenue Project will start with a six (6) month period for Private Utility Relocation.

After that initial six (6) month period, the Roadway and Public Utility Construction will start. That construction is scheduled for fifteen (15) months. Therefore, the projected completion date for the Clinton Avenue Project is 21 months from the initial Notice to Proceed or by about May 2014.

During this Public Workshop, representatives of the County and the Contractor will be available to provide information, discuss the Project, respond to questions and address comments regarding the Project. Project-related graphics and other material illustrating the Project will also be available for viewing. Thank you for attending and participating in this Public Workshop.
