FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 SECTION 5305 TRANSIT PLANNING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$ 188,757

The Pasco County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), the designated organization responsible for conducting a countywide transportation planning program, is scheduled to amend the adopted TIP at their regularly scheduled meeting on January 9, 2020 at 10:00 am in the West Pasco Government Center, First Floor - Board Room, 8731 Citizens Drive, New Port Richey, Florida, 34654. The purpose of this notice is to provide an opportunity for public comments and input on additional funding in the TIP. The FDOT has requested approval of a TIP amendment to update the adopted Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment updates the FY 2019-20 Section 5305 (d) Transit Planning Funding totaling \$ 188,757 in the Adopted TIP.

Pursuant to Federal Regulations and Florida Statutes, the TIP identifies a Five Year (FY 2018-19 through FY 2022-23) listing of all transportation projects and programs funded with Federal and State funds, within Pasco County. In addition, local funds (County/City) are also included on selected projects that maybe utilized through various State grant programs. The TIP amended page is available for public review and comment on the MPO's website (www.pascompo.net), and at the MPO Office in New Port Richey. Persons wishing further information or needing a copy of the Final Draft TIP should call the MPO at (727) 847-8140. The TIP covers a five-year period from Fiscal Year 2017-18 through Fiscal Year 2021-22 (July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017). and identifies multimodal transportation projects and programs that are proposed to be funded by Federal, State, (Florida Department of Transportation – FDOT) and local funds that are required to match various State grants for transportation projects.

In accordance with the MPO's Public Participation Plan and in compliance with Federal law - 23 CFR 450.316(b)(1)(i) and 339.175 (b) and (8) Florida Statutes and applicable Federal law, the public had a minimum 30-day comment period on the draft TIP was initiated in order to receive comments. The Public Hearing is

scheduled to also provide the public opportunity to comment before approval by the MPO Board. The final draft TIP may be viewed on the MPO's website at www.pascompo.net under "Public Notices/Hearings." Persons wishing further information or needing a copy of the Final Draft TIP should call the MPO at (727) 847-8140.

Individuals unable to access a PCPT bus to attend the meeting may contact PCPT at least five days prior to the public hearing to find out if they qualify for alternative transportation service.
