*Be smart, Recycle from home.* If you get twice-a-week curbside garbage pickup, you are already paying for recycling service. Please "Choose & Use Your Own Container" – *plastic bags are no longer allowed* – sticker it and put it at the curb the night before your recycling day. Get your sticker and schedule from your hauler. Put all your recyclables in the same container.

You can recycle aluminum cans, metal food cans, clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, and plastic bottles, jars and small containers coded #1, #2, #3, #4, #5 and #7. AND NOW, newspaper, mixed paper and cardboard. Please rinse items and remove caps before recycling.
